18 students were questioned. The answers were as follows:


1. What did you like during the meeting in Romania?


2. What did you improve during your stay in Romania?

Comments

Question 1

What did you like during the meeting in Romania?

Meeting new people (100%) and **getting familiar with new cultures (94.4 %)** were the most popular answers among the students regarding the mobility in Romania. Next in their preferences was the cooking workshop – traditional dishes (88.9 %), followed by the farewell party (83.3 %), sport activities (77.8 %), pottery workshop (72.2 %) and city game (72.2 %). Related to the topic of the meeting, more than half of the students enjoyed Romanian food (66.7 %), international lunch at school (66.7 %), lab activity: determination of foodstuff falsification (61.1 %), visit to a traditional animal farm (55.6 %) and Kahoot games on nutrition (55.6 %). Also more than half of the students liked the cultural visits to “The Egg Museum” (55.6 %) and Moldovita Monastery (55.6 %). What needs to be stressed is the fact that few students chose options strictly connected with the scientific research on the topic of the meeting: presentations of prepared materials (22.2 %) and workshop on product labeling (16.7 %).

Question 2

What did you improve during your stay in Romania?

The greatest outcome of the mobility is that **94.4%** of the students (17 out of 18) declared they have improved their **level of English** during their stay in Romania. Moreover, 88.9 % of the respondents improved their knowledge about the partner countries. What needs to be stressed is the fact that **61.1 %** of the students improved their **knowledge about healthy lifestyle** and **38.9 %** of the students improved their **knowledge about healthy eating**, which is the main goal of our project.
